(Miles) (marker)		Exit village hall car park
0.0	>>>>	Right at T Junction onto B1113 (<i>Chequers</i> pub opposite).
1.1	<<<<	Left signposted ‘Baylham Upper St, Nettlestead’ then left again.
3.5	>>>>	Fork right signposted ‘Somersham’.
4.2	>>>>	Right at T Junction onto Main Road signposted ‘Offton’.
5.1	<<<<	Left after <i>Limeburners</i> pub signposted ‘Offton, Bildeston’.
7.0	.^.^.	Tollemache Business Park sign on RHS
7.5	<<<<	Left at Give way sign onto B1078 signposted ‘Bildeston’.
8.4	<<<<	Left onto Taylors Lane signposted ‘Naughton, Hadleigh, Whatfield’.
8.6	<<<<	Left signposted ‘Whatfield, Hadleigh’, past <i>Wheelhouse</i> pub LHS.
9.9	<<<<	Left signposted ‘Elmsett’ onto Rookery Road then Manor Road.
12.0	<<<<	Left signposted “Ofton 2 , Needham Market 7” onto Ofton Rd.
12.0	>>>>	Fork right onto Flowton Rd signposted ‘Flowton, Burstall’.
13.1	<<<<	Left signposted ‘Somersham, Flowton’ then through Flowton.
16.6	<<<<	Left onto B1113 main road then immediately...
16.6	>>>>	Right signposted ‘Bramford, Ipswich’ onto B1067 The Street.
17.5	<<<<	Left onto Papermill Lane signposted ‘Claydon 2’.
19.6	>>>>	Right at A14 junction towards Claydon Caution oncoming traffic !
20.0	>>>>	Church Lane then immediately left into <i>Crown</i> pub car park.

- (Miles) (marker) Turn right out of the *Crown* car park
- 20.0 >>>> Right at T Junction onto Norwich Road then:
- 20.0 <<<< Left towards Great Blakenham
- .^.^.^ Under A14 bridge then railway level crossing **Caution trains !**
- 21.2 >>>> Right towards village hall signposted accordingly

Total 21.2 miles

Directions to Great Blakenham Village Hall.

Great Blakenham is on the B1113. Leave the A14 at its junction (No. 52) with the B1113 and follow the signs to 'Gt Blakenham'. In Great Blakenham, turn right at the 'Village Hall' sign into Mill Lane, opposite the *Chequers* pub. The village hall is along this road on the right.
